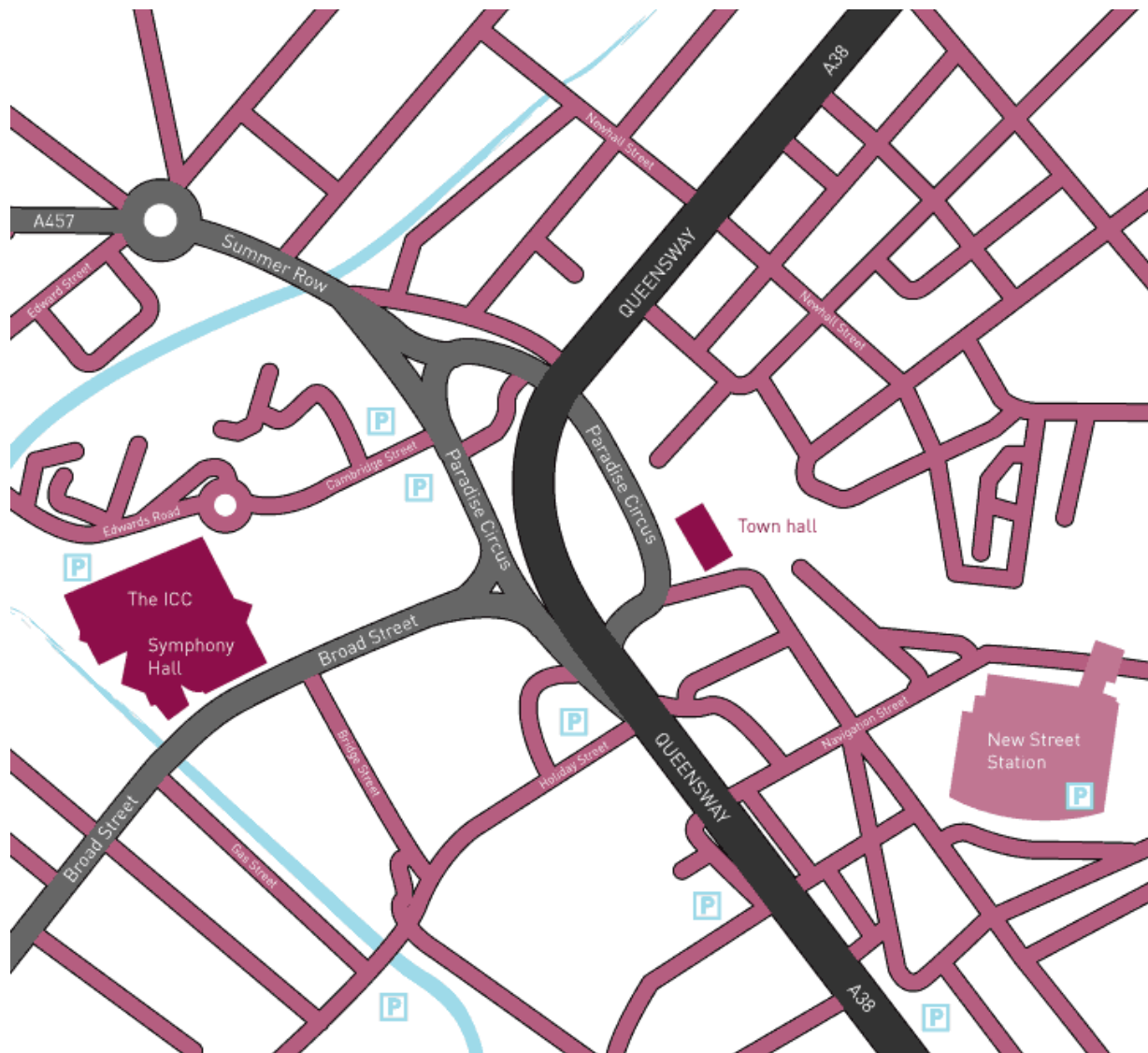


HOW TO FIND US



By Road

Birmingham is at the hub of a comprehensive motorway network that connects to every corner of the country via the M5, M6, M40 and M42. Follow signs to Birmingham City Centre then follow the brown tourist signs to the Convention Centre and NIA. (Symphony Hall itself is not featured on road signage.)

Taxis

There is a taxi rank across the road from Symphony Hall outside the Hyatt Regency Hotel.

By Rail

Birmingham New Street and Snow Hill stations are within easy walking distance of Town Hall and Symphony Hall. Moor Street and Five Ways are slightly further away but still within walking distance. (NB Birmingham International serving Birmingham International Airport and The NEC, is

approximately 10 miles away.) There are fast and frequent rail services to the centre of Birmingham with free parking at many Centro stations. The Centro Hotline on 0121 200 2700 (open 7.30am – 10.30pm every day except Christmas Day) can help you plan your journey.

By Air

Birmingham International Airport. Frequent trains to the City Centre run from the adjacent Birmingham International Station.
